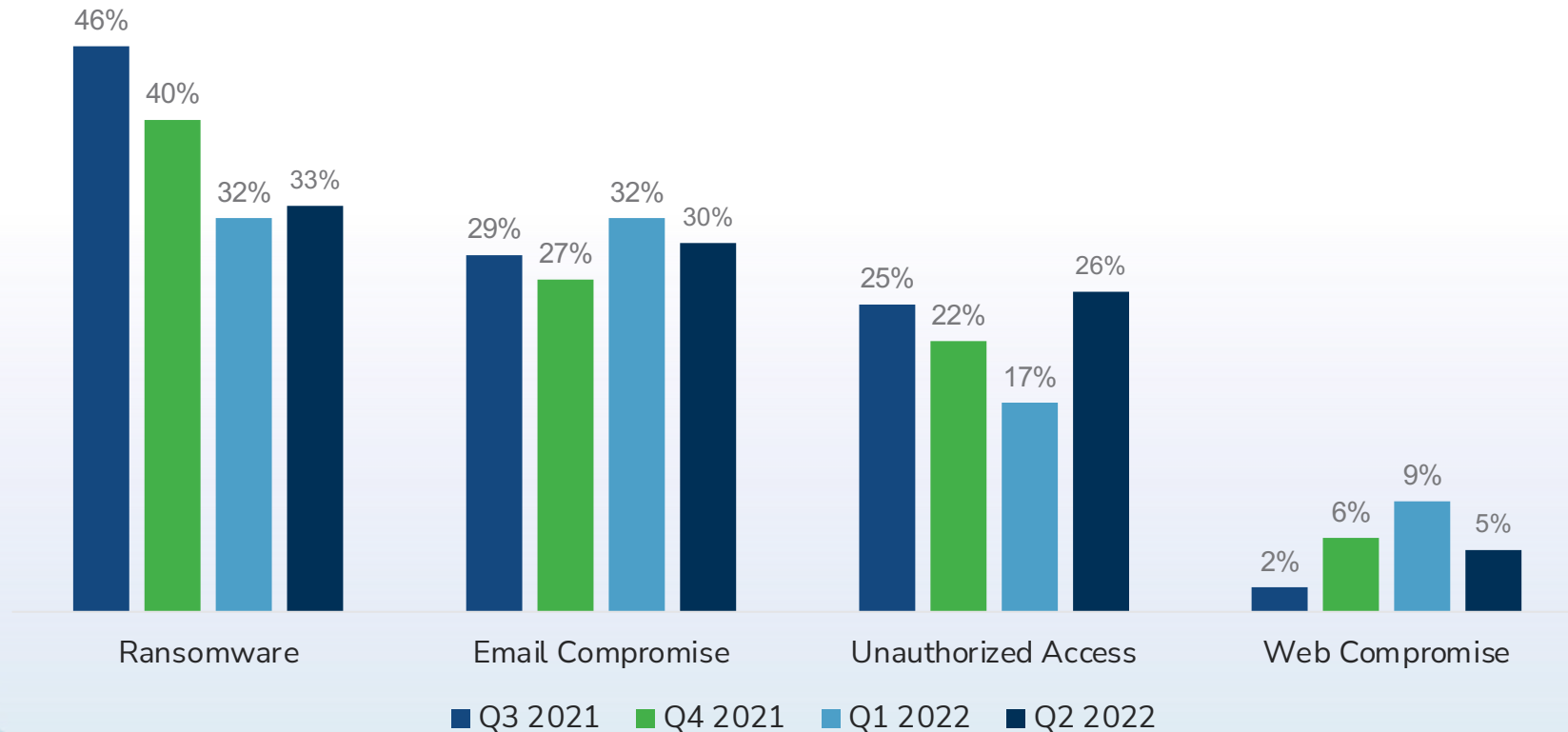

# State of IR

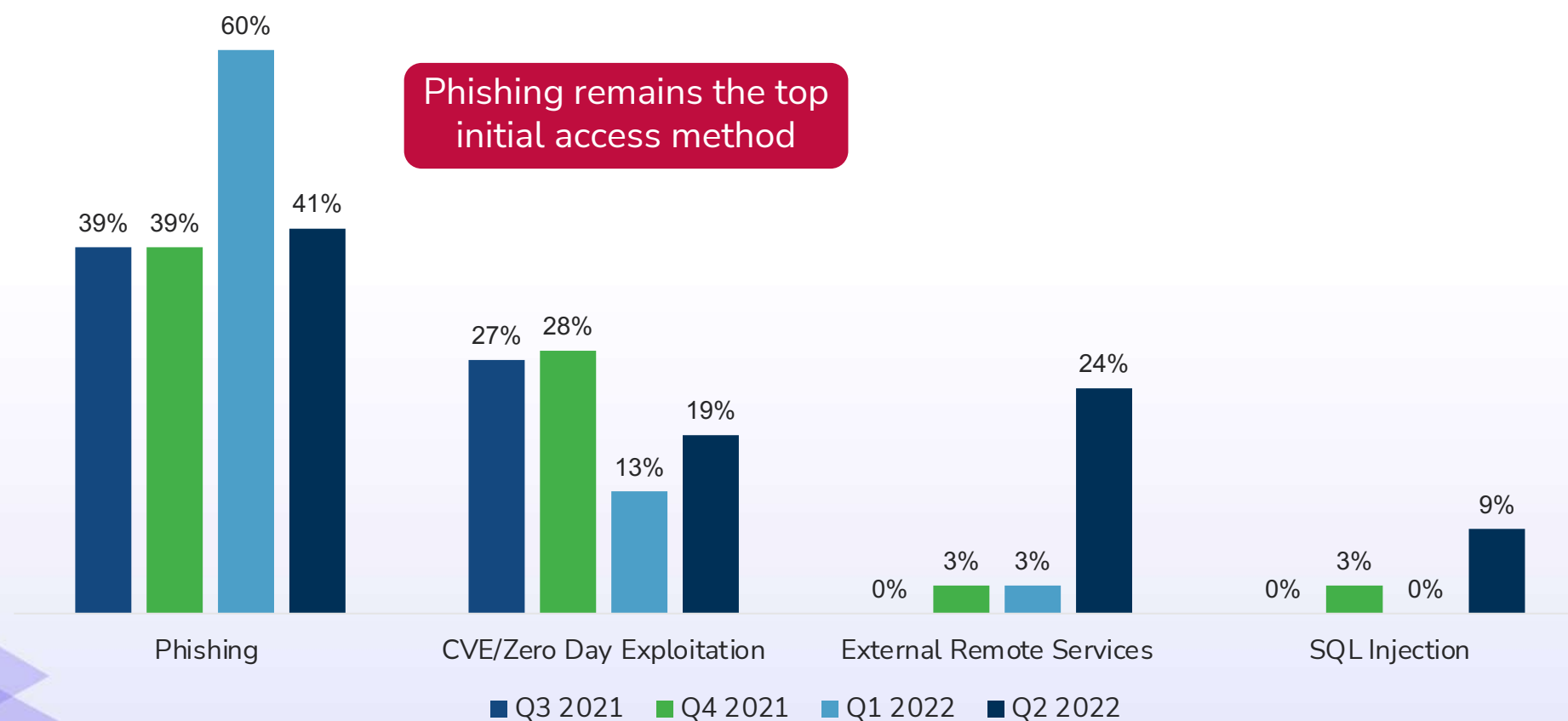
Once the UKR-RUS conflict subsides/stabilizes, Kroll expects a large surge in Ransomware cases – which has held true so far, especially into the end of 2022.

## Most Popular Initial Access Methods - Past 4 Quarters



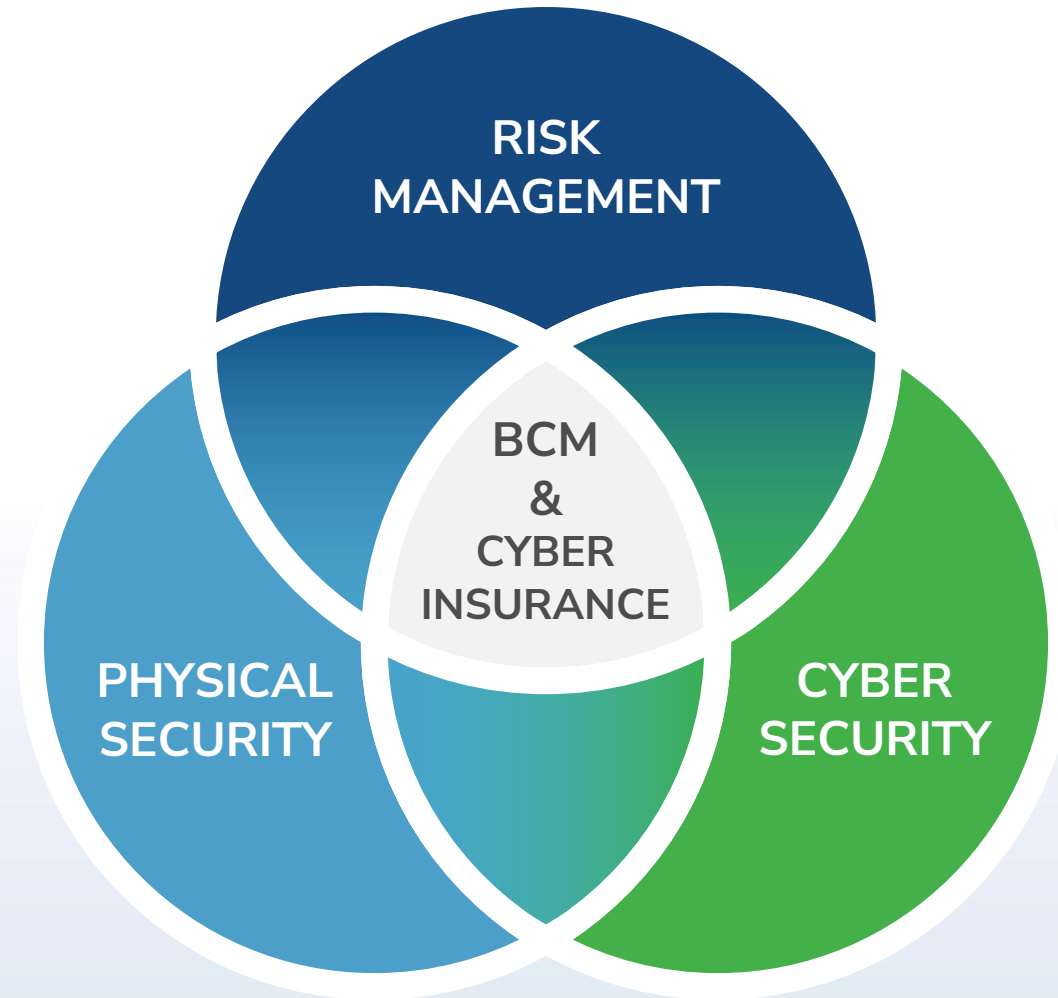




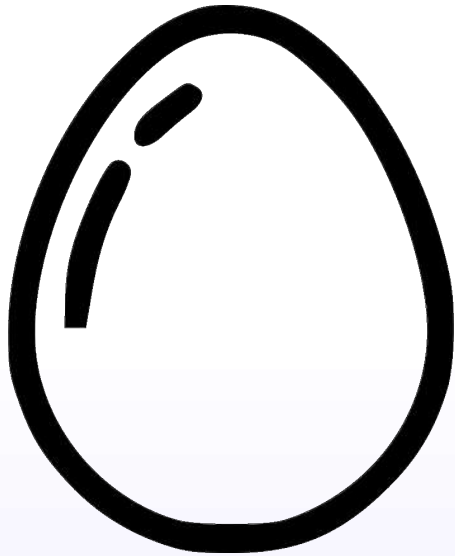

# The Security Onion

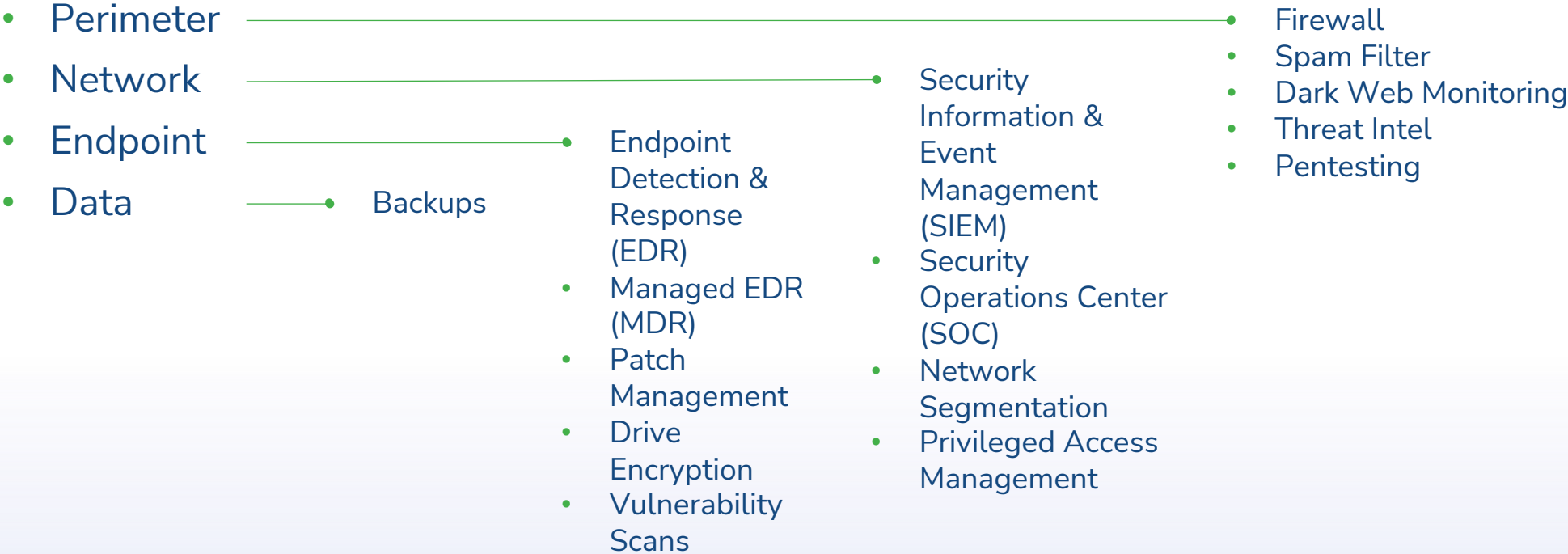

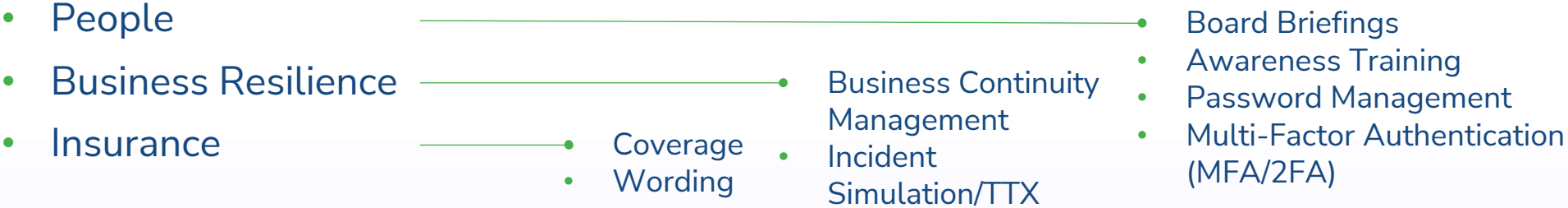
